Who are the courses for?

Courses are designed for **beginners** who have little or no previous knowledge of the language.

Any full-time student of De Montfort University can apply.

Each class has a maximum of 10 places.

The course will cover the basics of your chosen new language including speaking, reading and writing as well as some homework practice.

What is the cost?

The intensive course is £30, the textbook is included in the price.
