In 2018, YCU became the first university within the metropolitan area to have an undergraduate school specializing in the field of data science. It followed suit with the establishment of the Graduate School of Data Science in 2020. YCU's six graduate schools are strongly linked to our several research centers.

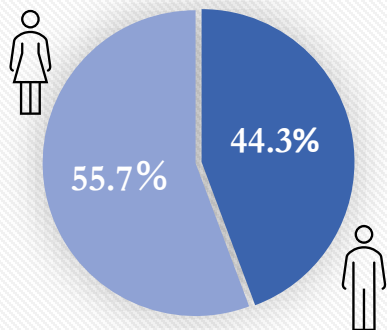
