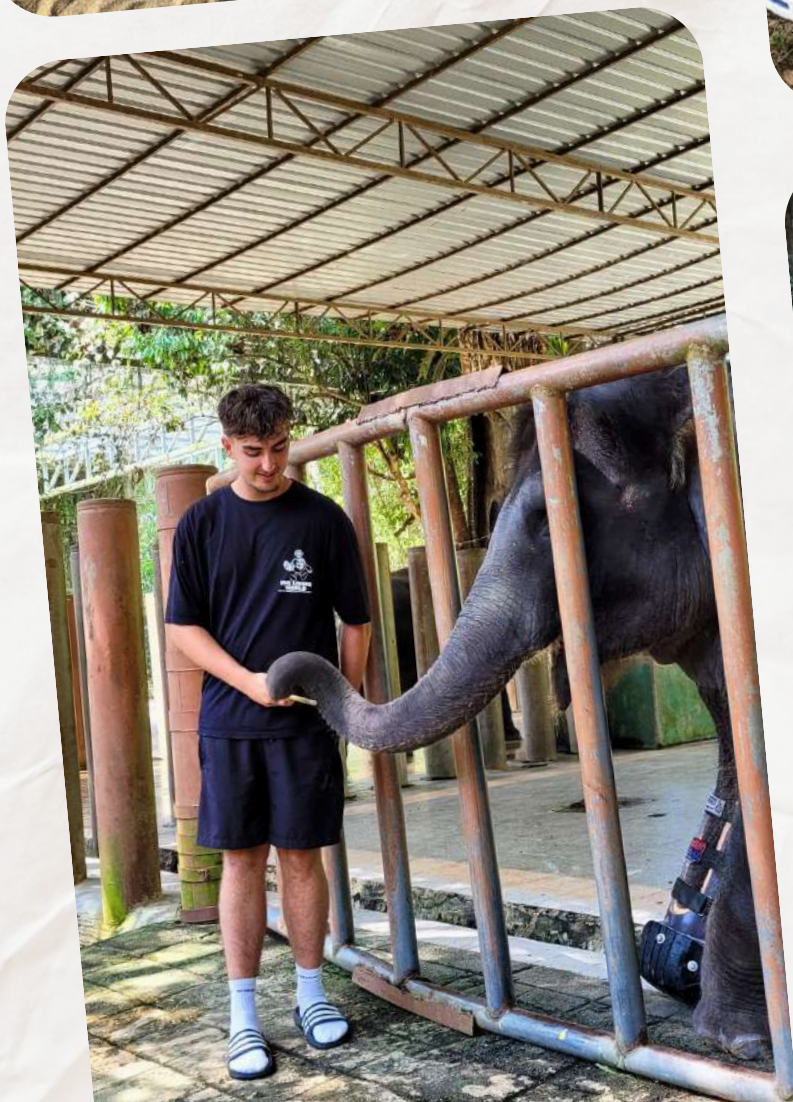


About US
